DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

FUNDING PROPOSAL

BACKGROUND

Volleyball Tasmania, with support from Volleyball Australia, has undertaken to implement a number of new projects to improve participation numbers, helping to meet some requirements of the Australian Sports Commission. The money is tied to goals including continued growth in player participation rates (both senior and junior), growth in the number of qualified coaches and referees and development in regional areas through affiliation of regional organisations. All projects should consider both disciplines of the sport (indoor and beach).

PROPOSAL

Funding is linked to specific projects (see below) with individuals, clubs, schools, organisations or businesses being able to place a tender to run the projects. Success of tenders will be dependent on the applicant's ability to fulfil specific criteria and accountability to Volleyball Tasmania for any monies spent.

Regional Projects (mirrored in South, North, North-West)

(\$12,000 available for the following projects)

- **Regional Athlete Development Programs** (\$1000 + \$1000 if able to attend AVSC)
This project is aimed at emulating the success of the Elizabeth College Athlete Development Program throughout each of the regions. This program will provide participants with the opportunity to learn how to play volleyball outside of school hours with the potential of participating in school and representative tournaments including Invitational Tournaments, Tasmanian Volleyball Schools Cup and Australian Volleyball Schools Cup.
- **Regional In-School Clinics** (\$100 per school up to 10 schools)
This project is aimed at promoting volleyball throughout the Tasmanian student and teacher population. Links should be made between these in-school clinics and ongoing volleyball opportunities such as Athlete Development Programs, School Competitions and Club Competitions.
- **Regional Schools Cups** (\$1000)
This project is aimed at providing the opportunity for schools to partake in a regional volleyball tournament. The tournament should aim to encourage continued involvement of the schools and participants in volleyball (specifically the opportunities to participate in the Tasmanian & Australian Volleyball Schools Cups) with organisers to research the potential of ongoing junior rosters in the regional area.

State Wide Projects

(\$3,000 available for the following projects)

- **Coaching Development** (\$1500)

This project is aimed at increasing the coaching proficiencies, experience and accreditation of the Tasmanian volleyball community. Organisers should be aiming to achieve specific goals as agreed by Volleyball Tasmania.

- **Referee Development** (\$1500)

This project is aimed at increasing the refereeing proficiencies, experience and accreditation of the Tasmanian volleyball community. Organisers should be aiming to achieve specific goals as agreed by Volleyball Tasmania.

If it is possible for the organiser to run these projects at a profit (either through organisation of sponsorship, partnerships, payment by participants) then **all** extra money can go to the organiser.

TENDER PROCESS

Volleyball Tasmania will create a sub-committee to run the tender process and selection of successful applicants. The sub-committee will also be responsible for the accountability process. No sub-committee member may apply to run a project. The sub-committee may decide that there are no suitable candidates and will thus leave the call for tenders open.

Timeline

- Call for tenders for each of the projects. Initially close 31st March 2013 (specific projects may remain open if unable to find suitable applicants)
- Review by sub-committee of applications
- Selection of successful applicants. Completed by 30th April 2013
- Project facilitators to provide monthly reports as part of accountability process (ongoing)
- Review of project funding by Volleyball Tasmania Committee (June 2013, December 2013, June 2014)
